

Maths



We will be exploring measures and recognising the units we use to measure different things in. We will continue to develop our confidence in using and applying numbers and calculations. We will become increasingly fluent at recognising and using all four operations (+, -, x, ÷) as well as being able to explain our strategies for working.

Science

In Science we will be looking at how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.



English



In English we will be developing our writing to include a wider selection of interesting word choices including adjectives and adverbs. We will be trying to write longer sentences using coordination and subordination. During our weekly 'Authors club' we will be producing longer pieces of writing in a range of styles. We will continue our weekly guided reading where we are developing our comprehension skills through both fiction and non-fiction texts. We will have a focus on play scripts – reading, writing and performing. We will continue to develop our phonic skills through daily phonic lessons. In our grammar lessons we will be exploring past and present tense verb endings and spelling words with a variety of different suffixes and prefixes.

R.E & PSHE

In RE we will be comparing Christianity to Hinduism focusing on the creation story. We will also be listening to, and discussing some stories from the Bible.

In PSHE we will be focussing our work on Rules and Responsibilities, beginning with Classroom Rules. We will then be preparing for our move to Junior School.

Computing



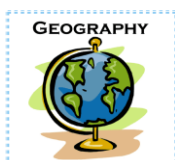
In computing we will continue to explore coding, developing our skills of writing simple algorithms and debugging when necessary.
