

## Maths



In Maths we will continue to develop our confidence in using and applying numbers and calculations. We will become increasingly fluent at recognising and using all four operations (+, -, x, ÷) as well as being able to explain our strategies for working. We will be exploring capacity and shapes – both 2D and 3D.



## Science

Through our Science work we will be identifying and naming common plants, finding out about the key structures of a flowering plant. We will plant seeds to help us develop our scientific skills of predicting, investigating and gathering data to answer key questions.

## English



In English we will be developing our writing to include a wider selection of interesting word choices including adjectives and adverbs. We will be trying to write longer sentences using coordination and subordination. During our weekly 'Authors club' we will be producing longer pieces of writing in a range of styles. We will continue our weekly guided reading where we are developing our comprehension skills through both fiction and non-fiction texts. We will continue to develop our phonic skills through daily phonic lessons. In our grammar lessons we will be exploring past and present tense verb endings and spelling words with a variety of different suffixes and prefixes.



## R.E & PSHE

In RE we will be thinking about how we care for others and exploring some of the stories Jesus told in the Bible. In PSHE we will be exploring British Values and how these affect our life and the way we interact with others. We will then be preparing for our transfer to the Juniors.
