

## **Primary Physical Education Sport Premium Grant**

### Amount of Grant received:

April 2017 to August 2017 - £3625

September 2017 to March 2018 - £10144

### How the Grant has been spent:

The Grant has been spent in a number of different ways to enhance physical education and activity across the school.

- We continue to be part of the Newark & Sherwood School Sports Partnership enabling us to take part in organised sporting events with other schools, such as tennis and the handball festivals
- We have purchased new toys to use in the 'Toyzone' and new soft footballs to use at playtime
- The PE Co-ordinator carried out an audit of the P.E. resources. In response to this audit and feedback from staff, the PE equipment was reorganised and updated e.g new hockey sticks, balls, beanbags, pop up goals, dance resources etc
- Rental of the Anomaly Board in the playground
- Outdoor learning equipment including nets, bug catching equipment, tweezers and magnifying glasses for use in the new school garden
- Sports Day Stickers

### Impact:

- Children benefitted from taking part in competitive sporting events with other schools
- Children learnt new sports such as handball
- Increased fitness and activity levels at playtime
- Improved and updated resources enabling teachers to deliver more varied and creative P.E. lessons
- Ball Skills lessons also enhanced by new P.E. resources
- The Anomaly Board encourages physical activity at playtimes, celebrates sporting success in our school and provides valuable information about mental health and wellbeing
- Enhanced provision for outdoor learning encouraging all pupils to spend time in the School Garden
- Encouraged and rewarded whole School participation in our annual Sports Day
