

English

We will have a daily English and Phonics lesson to develop our reading and writing skills, and explore a range of texts including stories such as 'The Singing Mermaid' by Julia Donaldson and 'Funnybones' by John and Janet Ahlberg. We will also read some poems and non-fiction texts. In our writing we will be learning how to write simple sentences using full stops and capital letters.



Maths

We will learn about counting, ordering and comparing numbers, addition and subtraction and solving word problems. We will also explore shape and pattern, measuring length and coin recognition. We will use many practical activities and games but we will also be working on recording our work.



Science

This term we will be learning how to identify and name a variety of materials and describe their simple properties. As part of our Seasons work, we will be doing a tree study and will observe the changes that occur through the seasons.



History and Geography

We are finding out about celebrations and traditions this term, such as Harvest and Remembrance Day. In History we will learn about events beyond living memory and find out about Guy Fawkes, and The Great Fire of London.
