Year 1 Christmas Visit to White Post Farm



Dear Parents and Carers

As part of our Christmas celebrations, the Year 1 children will be visiting the White Post Farm in Farnsfield on Tuesday, 19 December 2017. They will be leaving school at 9.15am and returning by 3.15pm. Transport will be on coaches which are fitted with seatbelts.

The children will be involved in a Nativity with the animals from the farm and also they will see Father Christmas! All children will be outside for most of the day so need to wear warm clothing, including hats and gloves & waterproof coats. The children do not need to wear school uniform.

Now that we are part of the new 'Universal Infant Meal Scheme' we can offer all children a packed lunch to take on the visit. The lunch will consist of a wholemeal cheese sandwich, a muffin, yoghurt, and a fruit bag. The children will still need to bring their own drink and can bring an extra snack if they would like to. If you would like to order a school packed lunch, please indicate this on the slip below by Wednesday, 29 November so that we can order the meals.

Transport for this visit works out at £4.00 per child & White Post are charging us £7.50 for each pupil so we are therefore asking for a voluntary contribution from parents and carers of £11.50. Contributions for school visits are voluntary but the visit may not go ahead if sufficient contributions are not received. Pupils in receipt of the Pupil Premium Grant are entitled to pay a reduced cost of £5.75.

We will need parent or carers to help on the visit, please let us know on the slip below if you would like to accompany us. If we have more volunteers that we need, we will give priority to our regular parent helpers as the children already know them.
